10 SECTION I:

9 TO: Create Emergency Guerilla Networks to Prepare for the Possibility of Armed Conflict
10 with the Aliens
11

12 SECTION I:

13 Standing armies and negotiations can only accomplish so much. While the UN should
14 prioritize communication, defence pacts, and peacefully calming the riots, it must also
15 prepare for the worst. If the aliens should attack and conquer large sections of the world,
16 current standing armies may not be prepared against the advanced weaponry the aliens
17 have. Guerilla networks will be key in resisting and countering its attacks, as well as
18 capturing any exotic technology the aliens field in battle. In the past, many countries have
19 prepared guerilla networks when faced with invasion. The Greek Resistance in WWII did so,
20 and successfully resisted and eventually repelled the German invasion by 1944, with only
21 marginal support from the UK.

23 SECTION II:

24 Kyrgyzstan proposes to create an organization that will oversee an international process
25 of moving weapons, telecommunications, and manpower to hidden locations among member
26 UN countries. These locations should ideally be in the countryside, especially in countries
27 with large rural areas. Military phones and the means to hide them will be provided to
28 civilians, so that they can communicate intel with their nation's forces. Countries that do
29 not have standing armies (e.g. Iceland) must quickly muster militaries. Most importantly,
30 countries must coordinate between each other to insure connected lines of communication
31 and action, so that guerilla movements can coordinate and eventually form an army capable
32 of resisting their alien invaders.

34 SECTION III:

35 Countries will fund their emergency networks at their own discretion, however each
36 participating nation is expected to contribute 0.5% of their monthly GDP immediately in
37 order to fund networks in underdeveloped or undefended countries. Further collections of
38 funds may be taken at the discretion of the UN Assembly if the crisis continues.

10 11 **SECTION I:**
